Because weddings are a flurry of excitement and special moments between loved ones, family and friends, it is important to not only capture those smiles, demure glances and beautiful flowers; stunning photography also captures the wishes of the client.

How can you be prepared for the biggest day of your life so far? Here, Kate & Jack share:

THE BEST ADVICE FOR A BRIDE.

"Make sure to have a close friend or relative help you keep track of time," says Kate. "In the excitement of the events taking place, it's so easy to run late, especially when so many of you might be getting ready together!"

THE BIGGEST SURPRISE ABOUT THEIR WEDDING DAY.

"We had an exciting moment when the ring bearer tripped coming down the aisle," says Jack. "He's this young nephew of mine and he really crashed. Then the flower girl went back, pulled him up, and they kept walking. Everybody loved that."

THEIR FAVORITE PHOTO MOMENT.

"We thought the formal photos were going to be the most important," says Kate, "but the candids turned out to be our favorites because we saw that everyone was in the moment as much as we were."

WHAT THEY LOVED MOST ABOUT WORKING WITH THEA DODDS

Jack says, "Thea at Authentic Eye Photography was really cool. I didn't know what to expect from a photographer, so when I saw pictures of people and things I never got to see during the day, I was pretty happy. She caught all of the details and got great shots of friends and family, too."

HOW TO TAME THOSE WEDDING DAY NERVES.

Kate says, "There's no real way to not be nervous, but I tried not to think about it, pretending we were getting ready for prom instead."

WHICH ONE MOMENT WILL LAST FOR THEM FOREVER.

Jack and Kate say they will most remember seeing Jack's brother cry at the altar. "My brother's a pretty tough guy, so seeing him tear up a little during the ceremony was enough to make me almost lose it. Thankfully, Thea caught him with his hand coming away from his face! It was really a cool moment to see him so happy for me."









GETTING MARRIED WITHOUT BEING HARRIED

- Be sure to have a hair and makeup trial at least a month before your wedding. This will give you peace of mind to know exactly how you will look and give you the opportunity to change things in advance if necessary. Make sure to bring all jewelry to the trial to see how makeup shades work with the pieces.
- Have your florist deliver your flowers to where you are getting ready, not the ceremony venue. Since you never know when the mood will strike for a great photo, you'll want your flowers there and ready to go.
- Find out what the rules for photographs are at the ceremony location. All venues are different, some restricting the location of photographs and even the times in which they are permitted.
- If possible, arrange to have your formal photographs taken before the ceremony. Getting this step out of the way early in the day frees up the rest of your time to spend with your guests. You will be able to go straight to cocktail hour and catch up with loved ones without stress. It's a new age, so it's no longer considered bad luck for the groom to see the bride before the wedding.
- Have food delivered to your getting ready location. It may be hectic, but take the time to have a bite before the wedding since it will be a while before you have the opportunity to nourish yourself during the reception.
- Prepare an emergency bridal kit with clear nail polish, mints, a sewing kit, stain treater, Visine, safety pins, bobby pins, pain reliever and mini deodorant.
- Allowing 50% more time for hair and makeup than you originally anticipated alleviates the number one reason wedding schedules end up running late. This will assure you have plenty of time for all the portraits you want to take before the wedding.
- Make sure you discuss a "rain plan" with your venue just in case Mother Nature doesn't see sunshine in the cards.





FROM SHOOT TO ALBUM

The weeks prior to and directly following your wedding planning are busy times. Here at Authentic Eye Photography we honor your harried moments with a special timeline which will help you to understand how we are working our hardest to avoid any unnecessary surprises:

Four-six weeks before your wedding: we send you a wedding information form to fill out all the details most important to you for capturing the best images possible.

Two weeks before your wedding: We chat on the phone a little bit about the day and discussing any last minute specifications

The day of your wedding: We arrive at the scheduled time and quickly run through the course of the day. Then we coordinate with your family and friends regarding scheduled start times for formal portraits and what to expect.

A week after your wedding: We collect all of your wedding images which will then be edited, retouched, archived and prepared for your online gallery or proofs.

Four weeks after your wedding: We post your online wedding gallery.

Five weeks after your wedding: We deliver your physical proofs as well as an online album pre-design.

Eight weeks after your wedding: You should complete your change requests to your album pre-design to us no later than eight weeks after the wedding so we can finalize your album design.

Ten weeks after your wedding: We "skype" for your album approval as well as to pick out your favorite components for your album in terms of cover materials, color and style. We can also use this opportunity to take orders for portraits, wedding party member gifts, parent albums, and any of the other unique keepsakes we offer.

Six weeks after your album is ordered: Your album and artwork are ready! At this time we also provide a client care card packet which will ensure a long life for your precious heirlooms. We ship your album and flash drive of final images to your address of choice.













STRIKE A POSE

Here at Authentic Eye Photography we pride ourselves in capturing the most natural, candid portraiture possible. This style showcases your day as it was, helping to bring your personalities forward and documenting your day for a lifetime of memories.

While we shoot the majority of our images this way, it's also very important to capture traditional formal portraits as well. Since our most important goal is getting you to your wedding on schedule, we allow 3-5 minutes for each desired grouping to ensure maximum results with minimal time. (Make sure all flowers and boutonnieres are delivered on time and affixed to family members and to the wedding party in advance.)

Because we prefer to keep the number of groups to ten or less for more intimate group shots, we always start with the largest group and break it down after that to allow for mingling. As time permits, we love to include a picture of the bride with each of her bridesmaids and the groom with each of his groomsmen, since each person has been invited due to close, personal ties with the couple.

If you have ideas for any 'can't-miss' portrait groupings you would like to see photographed during this time, make sure to note them on your provided wedding information form. We're happy to work with you to capture all of your special moments!

Engagements are so engaging. Romance is in the air and the anticipation of a lifetime together comes to a crescendo in the rush during the Weeks leading up to your wedding, causing you to wonder: Is an engagement shoot necessary? After all, your wedding pictures share the beginning of your life, right?

Shooting an engagement is important for several reasons. First, this time allows you to get comfortable in front of the camera with your photographer, figuring out how you work best together before the wedding. Next, you can showcase your personalities in a more casual

setting, while creating some fun captures for wall portraits, your wedding sign-in book, sign-in board and Thank You cards (shot early enough, we can also provide the images for your Save the Date cards and invitations). Images also add another dimension to your wedding album, chronicling the story from engagement to your wedding day.

Best of all, you can remember this special time forever away from the throngs of loved ones and friends. This is your time together.









Questions to Ask Every Wedding Photographer

Something I hear a lot is that shopping for a wedding photographer is hard work. Comparing photographer's packages are sometimes like comparing apples to oranges. Here are some questions to ask a photographer whom you are considering:

How long have you been in business? I started Authentic Eye Photography in 2004.

How many weddings have you photographed? I have personally photographed over 200 weddings.

Do you have experience shooting in various lighting situations? I've photographed in just about any lighting situation you can imagine. That is certainly a benefit to hiring a photojournalist! I have my lighting techniques down and I come prepared.

Do you sometimes book yourself for more than one event in a day? Weekend? I only do one wedding a day. Weddings are hard work, so I make sure my schedule allows us to give each wedding everything the client deserves.

Do you retain the copyright for the photos? Yes, but I do release the rights for reproduction if you purchase a disk. The only difference there is if I released the copyright it would mean I didn't take the photo. Releasing for reproduction means you can print to your hearts content, you just couldn't claim it as your own work. What kind of equipment do you typically bring with you on the day-of? I bring a lot of equipment. I have 3 professional cameras, 3 pro flashes, about 10 lenses, a studio light, light stands, diffusers, tripods, 100 gigs of CF cards and more. I don't use all this equipment at every wedding but this allows me to be prepared for any situation.

Do you bring back-up equipment to the event in case of malfunction? This is a must have. Too much is riding on a wedding day.

Are you available to shoot extra hours? 15 minutes before my time is up I always check in with my clients and see if they have any requests before I go or if they would like me to stay.

Do you charge for travel? If your wedding is outside of my local radius then there is a small travel fee.
