WONDER & IMAGINATION


5 or 10 day sessions

Wonder and imagination shape each day at the Barn Day Camp with campers chasing crickets, milking goats, and creating splatter-paint art. Campers delight in creative activities like climbing, costumes, greased watermelon races, and pirate gold hunts. All of our day campers experience a one-night overnight camping trip in a wilderness setting. Our oldest campers (9 & 10 year-olds) have the option to do a two-night overnight trip and enjoy adventures further afield. During these trips, campers experience the wonders of a wilderness experience in an age-appropriate way.



FIND COMFORT IN THE WILD

22-24 or 47 day sessions

Red Spruce Grove is a wilderness community structured around creating opportunities for campers to contribute directly to the creation of community. Campers distill daily life to the essentials: cooking over an open fire, building shelters, learning safe axe and knife techniques, archery, and other wilderness living skills. Throughout the session, campers are encouraged to think critically and solve problems in an experiential environment. Each session concludes with a 24-hour solo to practice the skills and independence learned from wilderness living.

22-24 or 47 day sessions



WHAT TRAILS WILL YOU BLAZE?

Lassic Questers 22-24 days

Traveling by canoe and foot to the peaks of the Adirondacks or the White Mountains for fifteen days. Culminate the trip with three days of rock-climbing. No previous outdoor skills are needed, just an interest and willingness to learn and become an integral part of a team.

Long Trail Questers
47 days

This Long Trail through-hike is geared toward success through learning and practicing extended-trip principles like map reading, back-country cooking, pacing, and appropriate packing. Long Trail Questers will learn the requisite skills of self-care, diet and how to handle the challenges of the 273-mile end-to-end journey
